- Prepare, as needed, for Day 2 content and presentations

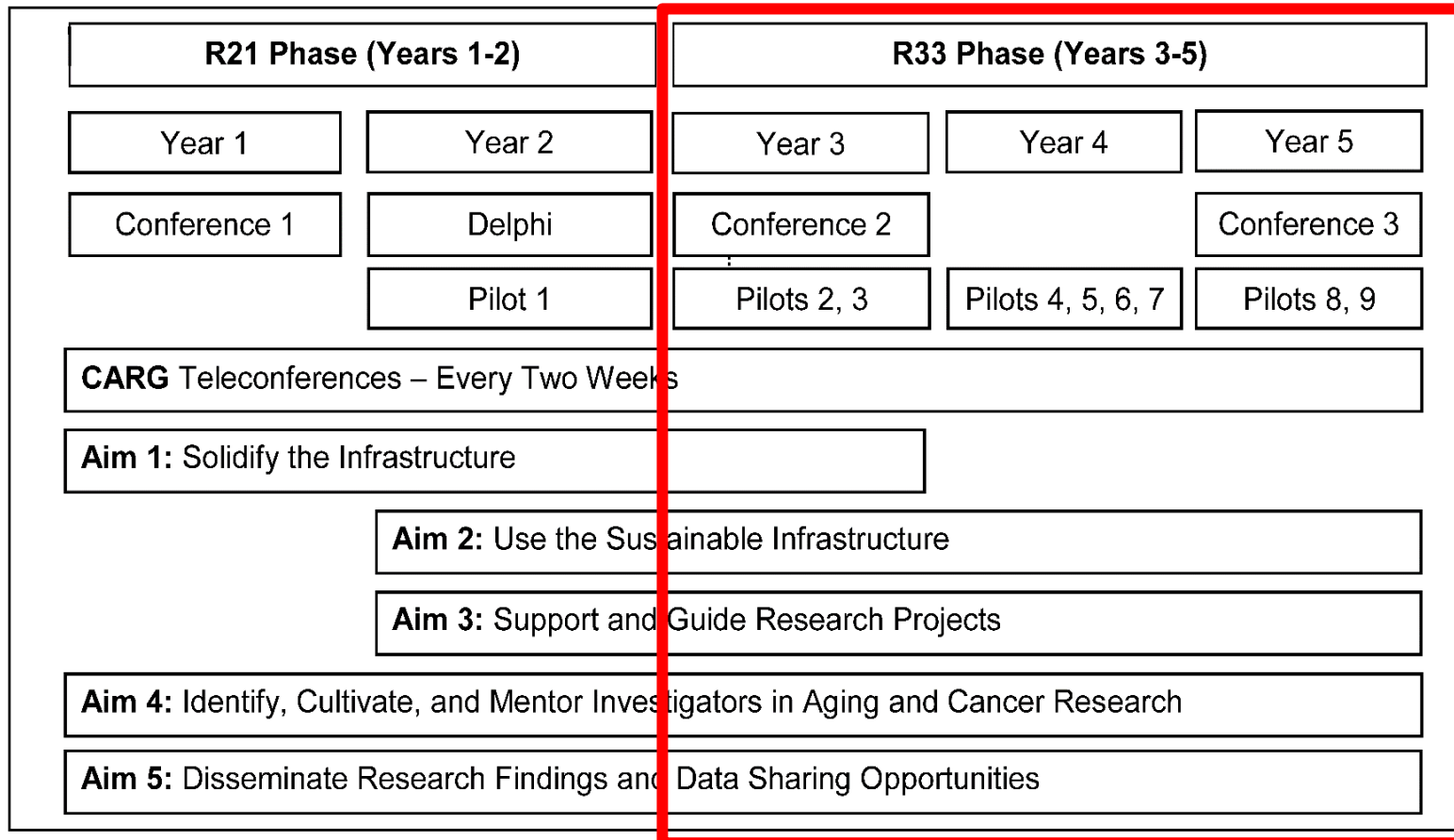

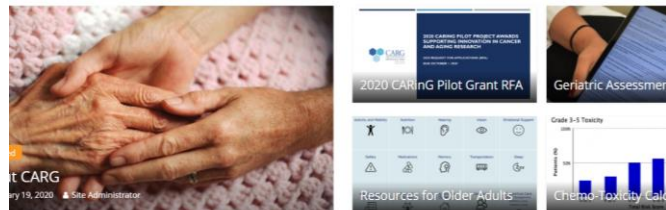
